Former archivist at the Thorvaldsen Museum. She has received several scholarships at The Danish Institute in Rome in relation to her research in Kierkegaard in dialogue with Thorvaldsen's art. She is working on a Thorvaldsen exhibition and a project about Søren Kierkegaard's influence on Nordic cinema, especially in Thomas Vinterberg's films. Fellow at The Danish Institute in Rome (Autumn/Winter 2020-2023). She is teacher of Italian Language and Culture at Studieskolen, School of Studies in Copenhagen; interpreter and translator (Søren Kierkegaard, Danish Poetry and Literature); Consultant for the Italian Film-Club at Cinemateket / The Danish Film Institute in Copenhagen.
